Our Business

WPX is a \$10 billion company that drills for oil in west Texas, southeastern New Mexico & North Dakota. Our headquarters is in Tulsa. We are a publicly-held company. Our shares trade on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol WPX.

Local Staffing

WPX employs 440 people in Tulsa. Our current office space is in the BOK Tower. We also have about 10 local job openings in engineering, accounting and geoscience. WPX careers, on average, pay more than \$100,000 per year.

Economic Impact

Our 2017 payroll in Tulsa was \$55 million. In 2018, we also paid out \$13 million in local bonuses in our annual incentive program. We also recently added \$5.8 million to our employees' retirement funds through our super-charged 401(k).

WPX has actually been around for 35 years. Most of our history occurred when we were part of Williams Cos. We spun off as a separate, independent company at the end of 2011. We are no longer affiliated with Williams in any way.
